Maternal and neonatal mortality in Burkina Faso is very high: **343 deaths** per **100,000** live births and **27 deaths** per **1,000** live births respectively.

By whom?


Delivered by **national experts** from the University of Ouagadougou and the Ministry of Health, and **at the local level by coaches** from the Health Districts.

Alternating long distance learning and face-to-face seminars


4 hours a week online for 🔀 months
